Appendix 6.

Anomalies of the six climatic variables used to calibrate the models: temperature seasonality (ΔT_{sea}), mean temperature of the warmest quarter (ΔT_{war}), mean temperature of the coldest quarter (ΔT_{col}), precipitation seasonality (ΔP_{sea}), precipitation of the driest quarter (ΔP_{dry}) and precipitation of the wettest quarter (ΔP_{wet}). Values go from strong decrease (blue) to strong increase (red) between current and 2080s scenario.

Appendix 7.

Pair plots of the three topographical variables (G, Slo, Alt) and the six climate change variables describing change in temperature and precipitation between future and current climate conditions (ΔT_{sea} , ΔT_{war} , ΔT_{col} , ΔP_{sea} , ΔP_{dry} , ΔP_{wet}). The lower/left panels show pair-wise scatter plots between each variable, and the upper/right panels contain Pearson correlation coefficients. Red lines have been smoothed using a smoothing spline (d.f. = 3).
