Figure A1.1 Marqués de Comillas Region

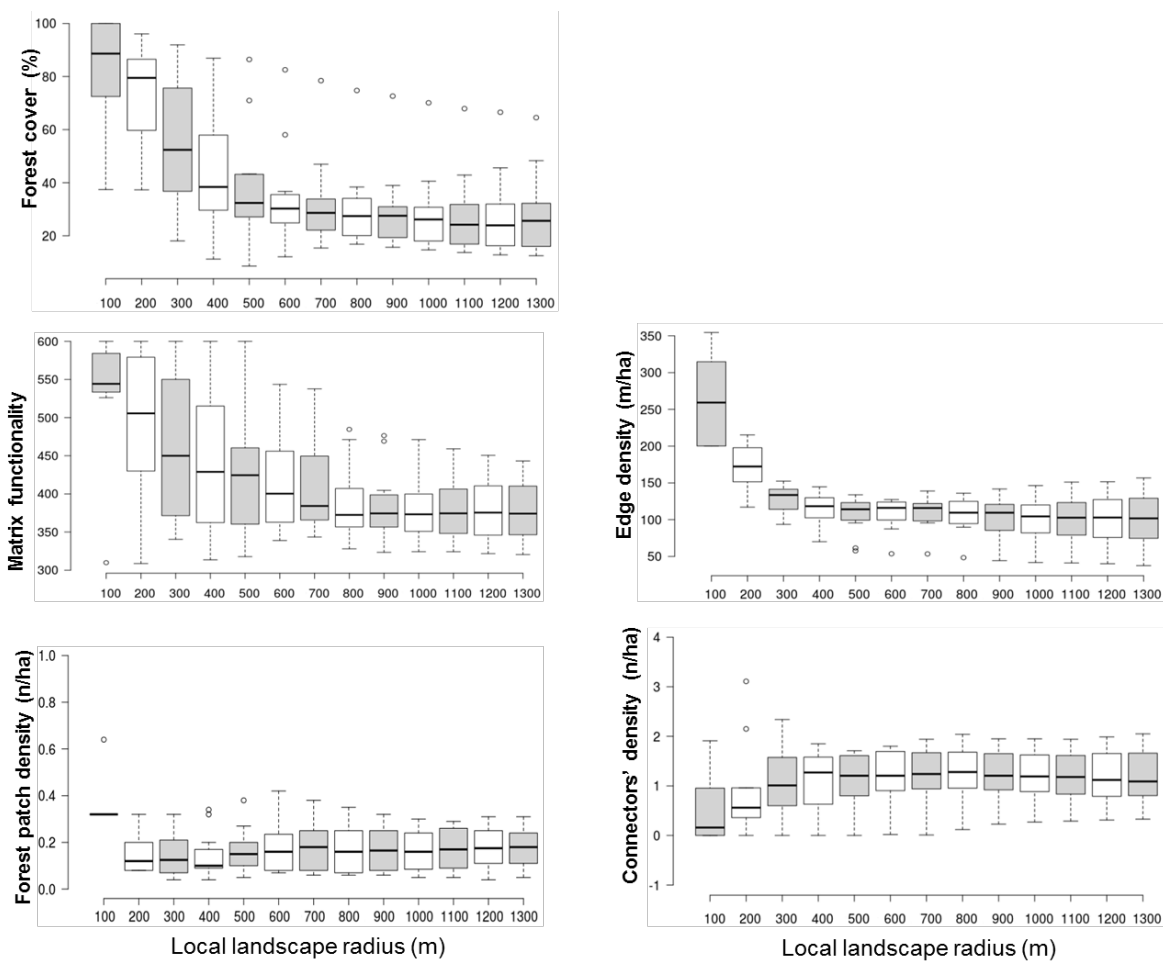


Figure A1.2 Uxpanapa Region

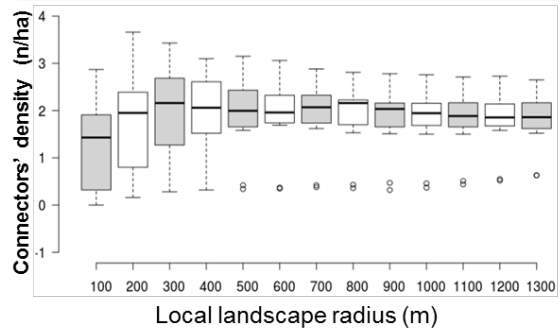
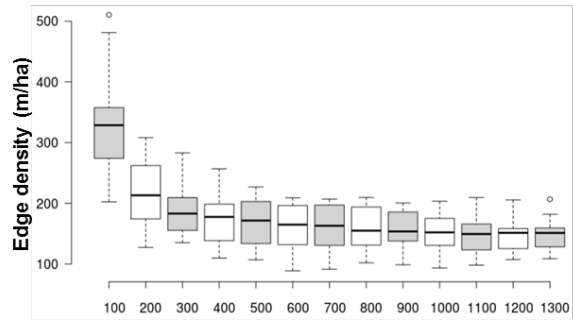
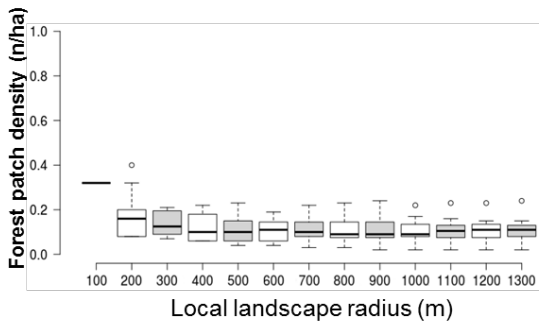
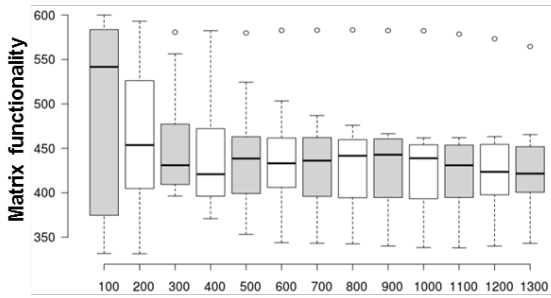
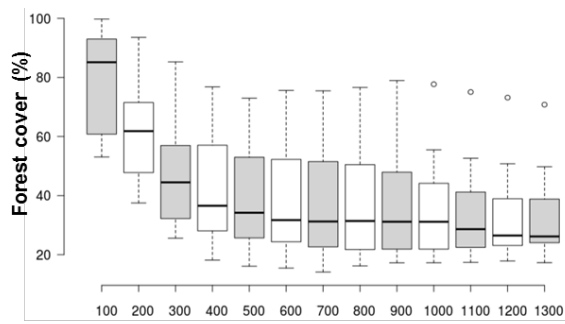


Figure A1.3 Los Tuxtlas Region

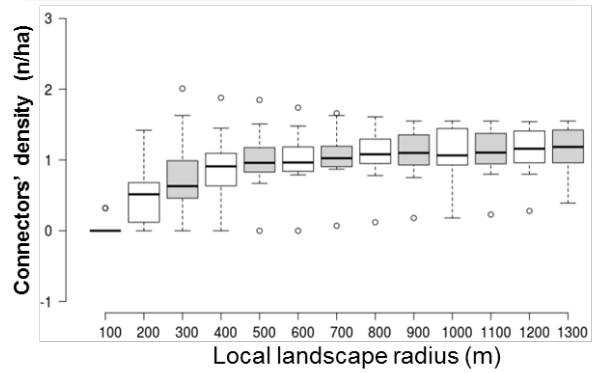
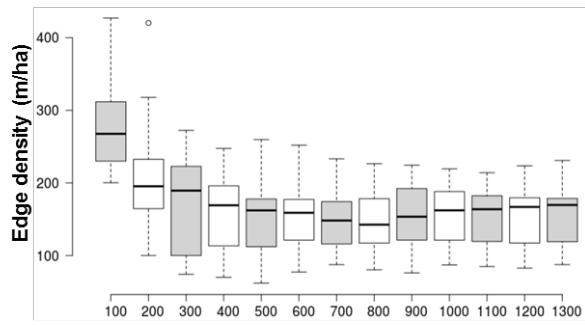
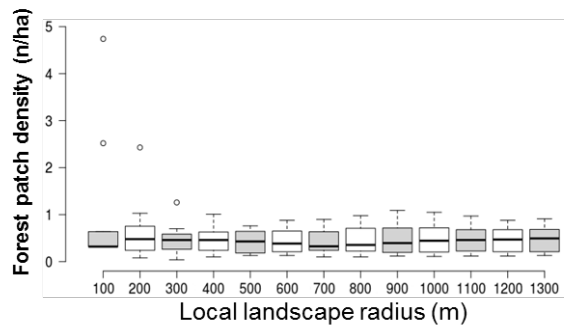
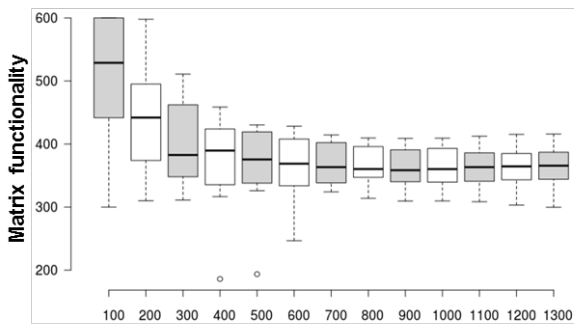
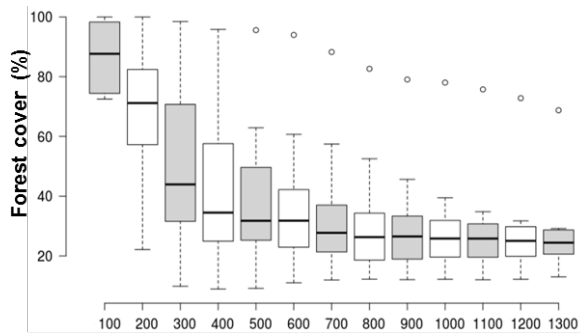


Figure A1.4 8th North Region
